## **To: Joint Petitioners**

If you wish to obtain a summary dissolution of your marriage, you must comply with a new law effective January 1, 1993. This new law requires that you file a disclosure of your assets and debts with the court before the court can grant your dissolution.

To comply with this law joint petitioners should use three pages of worksheets from the Summary Dissolution Information Booklet. Photocopy pages 9 (*Value and Division of Community Property*), 11 (*Value of Separate Property*) and 13 (*Community Obligations*), complete them, and attach them to the petition that you file with the court to start your dissolution.
